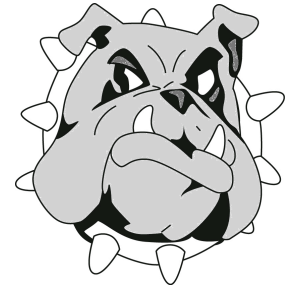

When placement of students is made, one of the main goals is to balance classes and student needs as much as possible. We welcome your participation in the placement process of your child for next year. If you have concerns to be considered, please contact the school office about receiving a Parent Input for Class Placement form. If you wish for your request to be considered for the 2019-20 school year, complete and return the form by May 12, 2019.

Did you know...

- We have had many questions about how Earl Boyles handles cases of **head lice**. Here is the language in the David Douglas elementary handbook.
- Parents are encouraged to check their children regularly for head lice.
- Students with live lice or nits will **NOT** be excluded from school, but will be allowed to remain for the rest of the school day.

Lice treatment information will be sent home with those who have either nits or lice. Please review the school district policy for clarification. All students may return to school after treatment has begun, and may be rechecked for live lice. Current evidence does not support classroom or school-wide screening as a measure for decreasing the incidence of head lice among school age children; such practices can deny students their right to privacy and to their educational time. If you have any questions, please contact our office staff.

- Also as a reminder, there is no **gum chewing** allowed during school. Students are expected to spit their gum out upon entering the building in the morning.

Thank you for helping us by reminding your child of this rule.
